In what language are you taught Comptia A+?

The course is in French.

Is the exam included in the course price?

Yes, the price of the certification is included in the cost of the course (\$253 for information only). You can take the exam at the end of the session.

How does the A+ certification exam work?

The exam consists of 2 performance-based MCQs of up to **90 questions**. It is taken online at an approved Pearson Vue test center.

Each exam lasts **90 minutes** and is available in English and French.

To pass this certification, you need to score at least 675 points in the first exam and 700 in the second, on a scale from 100 to 900 points.

Companies concerned

This course is aimed at both individuals and companies, large or small, wishing to train their teams in a new advanced computer technology, or to acquire specific business knowledge or modern methods.

Positioning on entry to training

Positioning at the start of training complies with Qualiopi quality criteria. As soon as registration is finalized, the learner receives a self-assessment questionnaire which enables us to assess his or her estimated level of proficiency in different types of technology, as well as his or her expectations and personal objectives for the training to come, within the limits imposed by the selected format. This questionnaire also enables us to anticipate any connection or security difficulties within the company (intra-company or virtual classroom) which could be problematic for the follow-up and smooth running of the training session.

Teaching methods

Practical course: 60% Practical, 40% Theory. Training material distributed in digital format to all participants.

Organization

The course alternates theoretical input from the trainer, supported by examples, brainstorming sessions and group work.

Validation

At the end of the session, a multiple-choice questionnaire verifies the correct acquisition of skills.

Sanction

A certificate will be issued to each trainee who completes the course.
